

## 2011 -Texas Rangers Overview-

1. We work all the Texas Rangers home games at the Ballpark. When you submit your availability, I update the Ballpark Schedule and make assignments. You can check the Ballpark Schedule at <http://www.shsraiderband.org/> to see when you are scheduled to work.
2. You must wear khaki pants or shorts (no shorter than 2" above the knee). Ball caps are also provided to you for \$5 each and will be taken from your account. Shirts are provided for you which must **not** be taken home. **In order that I have the appropriate sizes available, please provide me with your shirt size (men's).**
3. Unless you have a TABC badge, you will need to get a badge from me that will allow you to park and enter the ballpark. Let me know what is the best option for you, I can drop off at school or you can pick up.
4. You can park for free in Lot H, off of Nolan Ryan Expressway and ride the shuttle bus or walk to the stadium. Show the parking attendant your badge so you will not be charged to park.
5. Our booth number is 111, on the first floor, third base line, section 11.
6. You will enter the stadium at home plate at the employee entrance.
7. Arrival time for working the games is 2 1/2 to 3 hours prior to game time (gates open 2 hours prior to game) so we need to be open and serving food, etc. when the gates open.
8. If you can work, but can't be there until late or have to leave early, we will be glad to work around your schedule whenever possible. Please let me know your needs ahead of time so we can put you in the right places to work.
9. Carpools can be arranged if I know there is a need.
